WHY TAKE THE UWC ALUM SURVEY?

IT'S QUICK:

The Survey takes around 30-40 minutes to complete (time flies when you're reflecting on your life and your UWC experience!).

IT'S EASY:

All you have to do is visit UWC.org/ImpactStudy and click "Start the Survey" - you can complete the Survey in one sitting, or start and come back to it where you left off on the same device later on.

IT'S UNBIASED:

- The Survey is conducted independently by the Project Zero team and all responses are completely anonymous.
- The researchers want to hear every opinion - reflecting on both the positives and the challenges of a UWC education.

IT WILL MAKE A REAL DIFFERENCE:

- Results of Harvard's UWC Impact Study will be used to improve the UWC movement - allowing us to focus on what is most meaningful about a UWC education, and address those aspects of UWC that need work.
- The Study's findings will also inform the wider educational community, as well as help determine whether there are aspects of a UWC education that can be scaled for bigger impact.
